### **Scenario 2: Slow Building River Flood**

#### **Situation**

- Spring thaws causing flooding
- Additional rain is forecasted
- Severe flooding is imminent

#### **Issues**

- HAZMAT
- Hospital evacuation
- Temporary shelter evacuation
- Utilities

#### **Assumed Conditions**

- Develop your own community size
- Use a single EOC to coordinate efforts
- Follow the objectives on the handout

#### **EOC - Emergency Operations Center**

- Coordinates available resources
- May cover several jurisdictions
- Serves as County Warning Point
- Activates the Emergency Broadcast System (EBS).

#### **ICS - Incident Command System**

- Organized way of managing an incident
- NIMS
- Goal is to maintain effective span of control
- Basis of NIMS and ICS

#### **Standard ICS Chart Layout**

- Incident Commander
- Operations

- Logistics
- Finance/Administration

### **Operations Section**

- Reduction of the immediate hazards
- saving lives and property
- establishing situational control
- restoration of normal operations.

### **Planning Section**

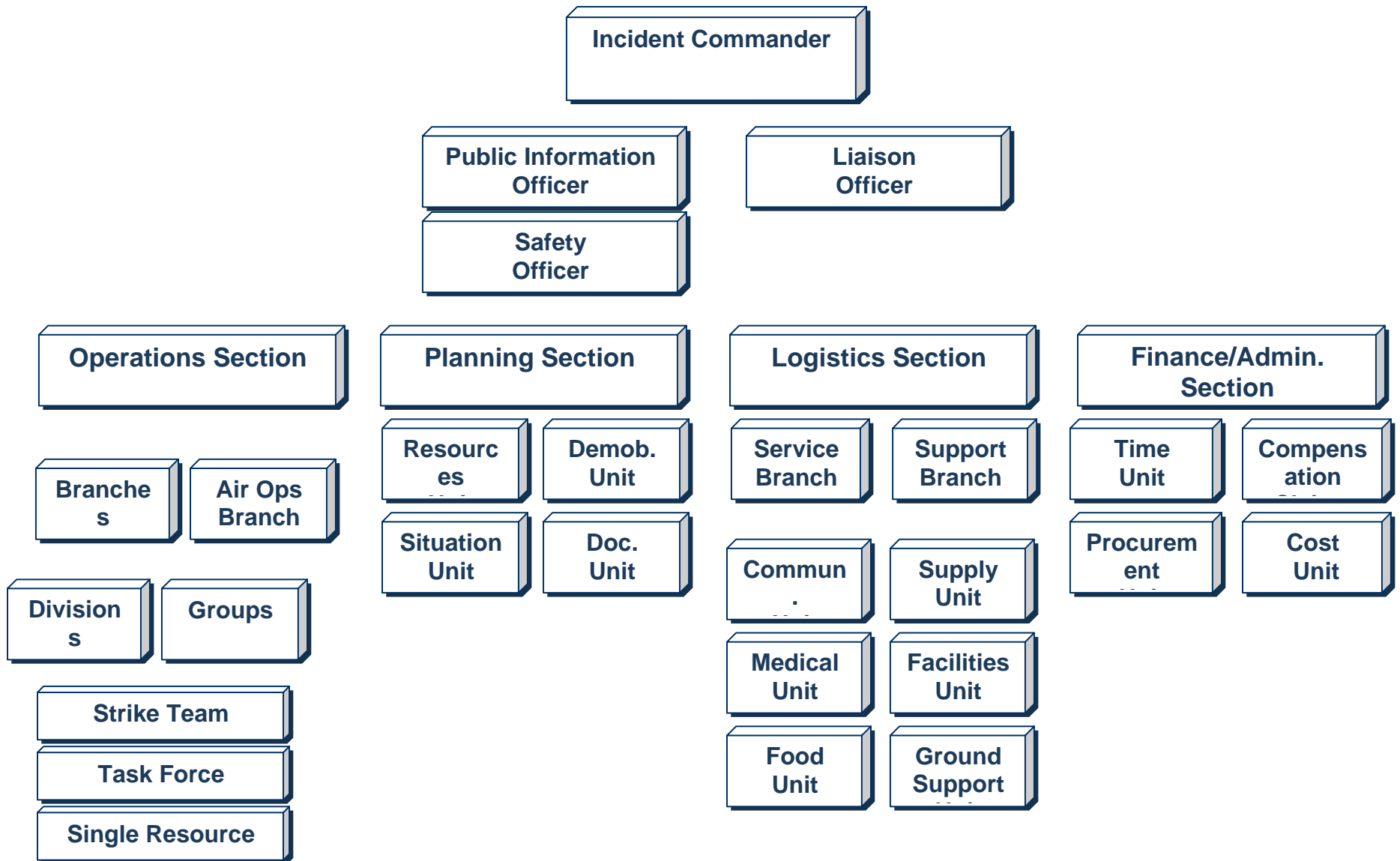
- collects, evaluates, and disseminates incident situation information and intelligence
- prepares status reports
- deploy situation information
- maintain status of resources assigned to the incident
- develops and documents the Incident Action Plan (IAP)

### **Logistics Section**

- Orders resources from off-site locations
- Provides facilities, transportation, supplies, equipment maintenance and fuel, food services, communications and information technology support, and emergency medical services for the responders

### **Finance/Administrative Section**

- Is formed when the incident scope or magnitude requires detailed financial documentation or further administrative support.
