

The Charles F. Carroll, Jr. Technology Scholarship Fund 2008-2009

The purpose of the fund is to provide scholarship support for students in the College of Engineering and Engineering Technology (CEET) who are pursuing a degree in Technology, with an emphasis in Safety, at Northern Illinois University.

The Award:

The scholarship is valued at \$1,000 for one academic semester.

Eligibility:

- Candidates must be an undergraduate or graduate student majoring in Technology with an emphasis in Safety in the College of Engineering and Engineering Technology at the time the award is made.
- Candidates must be in good academic standing with the university and must have an appropriately demonstrated record in the study of Technology and Safety. The quality of a student's prior academic record will be evaluated based on such criteria as the strength of prior coursework, other academic performance, professional experience, and recommendations received on behalf of the applicant.
- Candidates must demonstrate a desire to pursue a career as a safety professional. The candidate's intentions may be verified by reference to coursework related to a chosen field, through internship and employment experiences, by pursuit of a degree, or by other relevant means.

About the donor:

This scholarship has been established in memory of Jeffrey Allen Carroll, brother of Charles F. Carroll, Jr.

Charles (Chuck) F. Carroll, Jr. obtained his B.S. degree in Finance in 1985 and M.S. degree in Engineering Technology 1994 from Northern Illinois University. He currently has his own consulting firm in association with Insurance Office of America and has recently served as a Senior Vice President with Hilb, Rogal & Hobbs (Hobbs Group, LLC) leading the Construction Group. He has had the opportunity to work with several major corporations as an advisor and consultant including: Clark Construction Group, Dick Corporation, J.A.
